

## English Teacher

You will be responsible and accountable for all aspects of teaching and learning for your classes in the English Department, as well as teaching English as a second language. This is a great opportunity for a recently qualified teacher, or someone who is looking for a new challenge, and/or a completely different and unique teaching experience in this beautiful country of Nepal!

### **Key roles and responsibilities of the post include:**

- having a secure knowledge of English, and the related curriculum areas, foster and maintain students' interest in the subject, and address misunderstandings;
- demonstrating a critical understanding of developments in English and its curriculum areas, and promote the value of scholarship; and
- showing an understanding of and taking responsibility for promoting high standards of literacy, articulacy and the correct use of Standard English.

### **In addition, you will also be expected to:**

- set high expectations which inspire, motivate and challenge students;
- promote good progress and outcomes by students;
- plan and teach well-structured lessons;
- adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of all students;
- make accurate and productive use of assessment; and
- fulfil wider professional responsibilities.

All of our expatriate staff are volunteers. We cover the costs of the visa for the full-time international volunteer (visa post holder) and his/her dependent children who are studying at KISC, if required. A benefits package is also provided.
